He Will!

“This Jesus that you’re telling me about, He’d better do what you’re telling me. If I give my life to Him, then He’d better do what you say He will do.” Such were the words of the prisoner to the visiting minister, as he reached through the bars and shook the minister as hard as he could. The prisoner was not angry but earnest.

“He will!” was the emphatic response. With that, the power of God hit the place so that even the cellmates were laid out on the floor.

This same affirmation was declared by Jesus Himself. Another desperate man cried out to Him for mercy. “A man with leprosy came to (Jesus) and begged him on his knees saying, ‘If you are willing, you can make me clean.’ Filled with compassion, Jesus reached out His hand and touched the man. ‘I am willing,’ he said. ‘Be clean!’ Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cured” (Mark 1:40 – 42).

Do you need a healing touch from Jesus? Perhaps you are in a prison of your own making. He cares for you, and He will do what He has promised. In fact, we have God’s word on that.

“Has He said, and will He not do it? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?” (Numbers 23:19). “The Lord has spoken – he will surely do it” (Isaiah 25:8). “The Lord has said it, and his Spirit will make it all come true” (Isaiah 34:16). Thank God, He will “forgive all your sins and heal all your diseases” (Psalm 103:3), and “supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus” (Philippians 4:19).
